




Figure 3. Average number of citations per article per month as a function of the time of the citation relative to the time of publication. Citations at negative times occurred while articles were in their preprint form. Citations at positive times occurred after the publication of the articles. Data is from 26741 articles from the Journal of High Energy Physics and Physical Review D over the period from 1998 to 2007. The vertical bars represent the statistical uncertainty of the data, and are calculated as 1/N $(\Sigma_i(x_i-\langle x \rangle)^2)^{1/2}$, where the sum runs over the N articles receiving x_i citations in the same month after publication and $\langle x \rangle$ is the mean number of citations for articles at this time after publication.







Wiley's Self-Archiving Policy

Authors of articles published in Wiley journals are permitted to selfarchive the submitted (preprint) version of the article at any time, and may self-archive the accepted (peer-reviewed) version after an embargo period.



Author Self-Archiving Policy

Author's Original Version

The author's original version is defined here as the un-refereed author version of an article that is considered by the author to be of sufficient quality to be submitted for formal peer review by a second party. The author accepts full responsibility for the article, which may have a version number or date stamp and the content and layout is set out by the author.

Prior to acceptance for publication in the journal, authors retain the right to make their original version of the article available on their own personal website and/or that of their employer and/or in free public servers of original version articles in their subject area, provided that, upon acceptance, they acknowledge that the article has been accepted for publication as follows:

This article has been accepted for publication in [Journal Title] Published by Oxford University Press.

Once an article is accepted for publication, an author may not make the version of record available in this way or replace their original version with the accepted manuscript or version of record.

Accepted Manuscript

The accepted manuscript is defined here as the final draft author manuscript, as accepted for publication by a journal, including modifications based on referees' suggestions, before it has undergone copyediting and proof correction.

Authors may upload their accepted manuscript PDF to an institutional and/or centrally organized repository, provided that public availability is delayed until 12 months after first online publication in the journal.

When uploading an accepted manuscript to a repository, authors should include the following acknowledgment as well as a link to the version of record. This will guarantee that the version of record is readily available to those accessing the article from public repositories, and means that the article is more likely to be cited correctly.

The Scholar's Copyright Addendum Engine will help you generate a PDF form that you can attach to a journal publisher's copyright agreement to ensure that you retain certain rights.

Description

Each addendum gives you non-exclusive rights to create derivative works from your Article and to reproduce, distribute, publicly perform, and publicly display your article in connection with your teaching, conference presentations, lectures, other scholarly works, and professional activities. However, they differ with respect to how soon you can make the final published version available and whether you can authorize others to re-use your work in various ways. Below is a summary of the available options.

Science Commons / SPARC Addendum

Access - Reuse:

You retain sufficient rights to grant to the reading public a Creative Commons Attribution Non Commercial license or similar license that allows the public to re-use or re-post your article so long as you are given credit as the author and so long as the reader's use is non-commercial. (This is a joint offering from Science Commons and SPARC and represents a new version of the former SPARC Addendum.)

Other Options From Science Commons

Immediate Access:

You retain sufficient rights to post a copy of the published version of your article (usually in pdf form) online immediately to a site that does not charge for access to the article. (This is similar in many ways to the MIT Copyright Amendment below)


Delayed Access:

You also have the right immediately to post your final version of the article, as edited after peer review, to a site that does not charge for access to the article, but you must arrange not to make the published version of your article available to the public until six months after the date of publication.

Additional Options from MIT

MIT Copyright Amendment:

Developed at MIT, this amendment is a tool authors can use to retain rights when assigning copyright to a publisher. It will enable authors to continue using their publications in their academic work at MIT, to deposit them into the MIT Libraries' DSpace repository, and to deposit any NIH-funded manuscripts on the National Library of Medicine's PubMed Central database. - Якщо Ви журнал відкритого доступу зобов'язуйте архівувати видавничий PDF
- Якщо Ви журнал традиційної бізнес-моделі встановіть ембарго на самоархівування, або дозвольте архівувати поспринти (із обов'язковим посиланням на видавця та присвоєне DOI з видавничим префіксом

Рекомендації авторам

- Препринт до рецензування можна архівувати без порушення правил
- Автор є власником інтелектуальних прав на публікацію
- Якщо журнал не займається активно промоцією чи не є відкритого доступу – самоархівування рекомендується для розбудови власного іміджу
- о Перевіряйте політики журналу на SHERPA/ROMEO
- о Під час укладання угоди передбачайте можливість самоархівування та запитуйте у видавця про постпринт
- Обирайте для самоархівування надійні репозитарії з якісними метаданими та хорошим індексуванням
