#### The West should realize Putin won't stop with Ukraine

Russia recognizes IDs from so-called DNR, LNR

<u>Putin won't stop in Ukraine. The West should realize this.</u> Poroshenko.

Ukrainian President Petro Poroshenko says <u>he</u> received a "very strong message supporting Ukraine" in a meeting with U.S. Vice President Mike Pence and recent talks with other top U.S. officials.

Three years have passed since the Euromaidan revolution. February 18-22, 2014 marked the bloodiest days. More than a hundred died and over 1500 were wounded. <u>Ukrainians honor fallen protesters</u>.

Russia has recognized identity (ID) "documents" issued by the so-called "DNR" and "LNR", according to a decree issued by Russian President Vladimir Putin.

10 people were injured in clashes between police and protesters in the center of Kyiv. Protesters wanted to gather outside the Presidential Administration building on Bankova Street to demand suspending trade with occupied areas in Donbas.

"300,000 people will become unemployed," - Poroshenko voices threats posed by full-scale Donbas blockade.

#### New cease-fire agreed for Ukraine, but tensions still high

Pope to allocate EUR 200,000 for besieged Avdiivka residents

Feb 19. <u>Ukrainian troops repel Russian attack near Avdiyivka</u> on Sunday morning. <u>Militants shelled Ukrainian positions 105 times</u>, nine servicemen wounded. <u>Water, power supply halted as over 300 shells lobbed near Avdiivka</u>.

A new <u>cease-fire has been agreed to for eastern</u> <u>Ukraine, but some Russia-backed separatists could</u> <u>not say if they would respect</u> the halt to fighting, and a Ukrainian leader said he was not pleased with the results of a four-party meeting in Munich.

The leader of the so-called "Donetsk People's Republic" threatens to launch an offensive on Ukraine-controlled areas of Donbas.

Ukrainian air force on high guard. UATV went into the cockpit of a flight simulator identical to the MiG-29, or Fulcrum, as it's known by NATO. Ukrainian pilots use it to practice taking off from any airfield at any time and in any weather.

"We would lie in the snow for five hours. Now we know how to fight," - Ukrainian scouts near Avdiivka.

The Pope will allocate EUR 200,000 for Ukraine Humanitarian Initiative to address the needs of Avdiivka residents in Donetsk region, which recently suffered heavy shelling.

Russian nationalist writer Zakhar Prilepin has openly joined the Russian collaborative forces in the occupied parts of Donbas and says <u>his ultimate goal</u> is to march on the Ukrainian capital Kyiv.
