He died on August 6, almost six months after the February 12 cease-fire; and was one of 18 Ukrainian soldiers to die in the 10-day stretch from August 1 to August 10. 98 Ukrainian soldiers were wounded in combat during the same period. http://goo.gl/YDRnB2

Russian occupation threatens very existence of Crimean Tatar people

Ukrainian filmmaker O. Sentsov stood before a Russian court in Rostov-on-Don on Aug. 19 to offer a defiant closing statement in his trial for alleged conspiracy to commit terrorism. In his remarks, he challenged the legitimacy of an occupied Crimea "governed by criminals", and he spurned a path of "cowardice" that might accommodate or excuse Moscow's actions in Ukraine. The Odesa reform package that will be presented to Parliament in September includes legislation addressing deregulation, improving customs clearance, abolishing licenses in some industries, and lifting the moratorium on the sale of agricultural land. http://goo.gl/s02D3I
