The techniques necessary for this step have been developed by the project "Automatic Enhancement of OAI Metadata", funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG).

At the moment, DDC numbers are assigned to more than **1 mio. documents** in the BASE index and can be found that way. Please consider that there are some sections where you can't find any documents at the moment.

A quarter-century ago, Robert Mnookin and Lewis Kornhauser wrote a brilliant article explaining that litigants in civil cases bargain "in the shadow of the law."<sup>1</sup> What that wonderful phrase means for any particular class of cases is a very complicated matter, but the basic point is simple: there is a market for settlements in civil cases, and that market internalizes the governing law.

Criminal litigation likewise has a working settlement market. So one might suppose that the Mnookin-Kornhauser thesis applies to criminal settlements — mostly, plea bargains — as it does to their civil counterparts. As Stephanos Bibas rightly argues in his article in this issue,<sup>2</sup> that is not so: in a variety of ways and for a variety of reasons, criminal settlements do not efficiently internalize the law.<sup>3</sup> I could quibble with a couple of Bibas's examples, but his basic claim — that there are serious impediments to efficient bargaining in criminal cases — is true and important. His article makes a substantial contribution to our understanding of how the strange and inefficient market for plea bargains works, or fails to.

There is, though, a deeper problem with plea bargains, one that goes squarely to the relationship between those bargains and the bodies of law that define crimes and sentences. The problem is that law's effect on plea bargaining is much smaller than conventional wisdom

Regardless of the contribution of many research studies up to now, various challenges still need to be addressed: firstly, studies continue to view culture as well integrated and shared equally among organizational members; secondly, there is a tendency for studies to downplay the dynamics of culture and how this influences IS adoption over time; and thirdly, there is an increased need to analyze culture using in-depth interpretative and longitudinal methods. This paper proposes that our understanding of IS culture can be enhanced by combining theoretical approaches in which the weakness of one approach can be complemented by the strength of another. More specifically, by combining Martin's (2002) three perspectives on culture — integration, differentiation and fragmentation and grid and group cultural theory (for instance, Douglas, 1970; Thompson et al., 1990), can offer a more penetrating account of how organizational culture influences IS adoption. This argument is demonstrated using an in-depth interpretative (retrospective) case study of a further and higher education college in the UK and its unsuccessful attempt to adopt a virtual learning environment (VLE).
