Obama extends sanctions on Russia until March 2018

Poroshenko, Biden meet one last time in Kyiv

"Ukraine will not remain under Russian influence anymore, because the <u>authorities and people are</u> working to build a new state," President Petro Poroshenko noted after meeting with U.S. Vice President Joseph Biden.

Biden hopes next U.S. administration will support Ukraine, says Ukrainians still to do hardest work.

U.S. President Barack Obama on January 13 extended all U.S. sanctions on Russia over its annexation of Crimea and aggression in Ukraine by one year through March 2018.
