Not one step further until Russia honors Donbas commitments

"To become exhausted from Ukraine" and to ignore Russia's crimes in Ukraine, and return to "business as usual" with Russia are being considered now as an offensively realistic option again. imposed on Ukraine's ousted former president, Yanukovych, his son, and the former head of the presidential administration Andriy Klyuyev.

### Lethal aid for Ukraine way to resolve Donbas conflict

**OSCE doesn't see Russian troops in Donbas** 

The only way to end the conflict in Ukraine is to supply lethal weapons to Ukraine, according to Czech Republic's Jaromir Stetina, Member of the European Parliament, who paid a visit to Donbass.

OSCE monitors do not report on Russian troops in Donbas, because <u>those soldiers do not sport the</u> <u>Russian insignia on their uniform</u>.


