Russia's Azov blockade

May 21. JFO scouts eliminate Russian mercenary, capture three more in raid near Holmivskyi village. 55 attacks on Ukrainian troops in last day. Occupiers attacked residential houses. Militants shelled rehabilitation center in Donetsk region: 28 children evacuated.

Russian-backed forces <u>blow up bridge on</u> Khrustalniy–Luhansk route.

Hot war still raging in Ukraine's Donbas, and it's far from a frozen conflict.

Ukrainian female veteran <u>asks Russian diplomat:</u> "Why are you killing our people?" Then this happens.

<u>Ukrainian vessels' access to Sea of Azov partly limited</u> by Russia over alleged live-fire exercise.

<u>Russia's Azov blockade</u>. How the Kerch bridge built by Russia blocks and threatens the ports in Mariupol and Berdiansk.
