Current issues:

Postmodern literary criticism is a specific form of reading attention that is only possible in the cultures with strong interpretative traditions

In postmodern culture literary canon is re-shaped as a field of hermeneutical debates instead of presentation of critical consensus

Canonical literature is interpreted not as the embodiment of aesthetical values, but as source of "cultural grammar"

The interpretative logic of postmodern literary criticism is speculative

Summary

In process of canonization the postmodern critical discourse blurs the distinction between judgment of taste and pragmatics of opinion

- To explore the specific critical attention attributed to canonical text in postmodern culture.
