Feb 5. Russian troops <u>attacked Ukraine 115 times in Donbas</u>, <u>used Grad rocket systems</u>. Three Ukrainian soldiers killed in the past 24 hours. <u>Offensive against Ukraine near Avdiyivka on Saturday successfully repelled</u>.
