Russia jails prominent Crimean Tatar lawyer defending Ukrainian POWs

Russia invents 'Donbas link' to justify its Azov Sea attack on Ukraine and seizure of 24 POWs.

<u>Russia jails prominent Crimean Tatar lawyer</u> <u>defending Ukrainian POWs</u> TWICE for a video posted in 2013.

Russia brings <u>Soviet-style repression to occupied</u> <u>Crimea</u>.

Crimean Solidarity rights activist added to Russia's List of <u>'terrorists & extremists' for a</u> <u>Facebook repost</u>.

Over <u>105,000 Russians resettled to Russian-</u> occupied Crimea. Tortured and jailed for 10 years as Kremlin's revenge for Euromaidan in Ukraine.

<u>77-year-old Russian human rights defender jailed</u> for Facebook repost in support of political prisoners.

Russia imprisons <u>wheelchair-bound man with</u> severe muscular dystrophy on 'terrorism' charges.

Mikhail <u>Zhyzneuski, who was shot dead during</u> <u>the Euromaidan protests of 2014</u>, is considered a hero in Ukraine. But in his home city of Homel in Belarus, his grave has been vandalized and his family say they have been treated as pariahs.
