Russia has evicted illegally from Crimea at least 2,425 people

<u>Council of Europe chief formally requested</u> Russia's Putin to pardon Sentsov.

<u>Kremlin says Sentsov won't be pardoned</u> at Jagland's request.

Oleg <u>Sentsov</u> is using the only weapon he has – his body.

Ukrainian human rights commissioner, journalists not allowed to visit Sentsov in penal colony.

Russia pushes lies and defamation while hiding Sentsov who is reportedly very weak.

<u>Sentsov fed with unknown substance</u> since June 8 – Ombudsperson.

Russia blocks medication for abducted Ukrainian student Hryb with life-threatening illness.

Volodymyr <u>Balukh's health has deteriorated</u> sharply. Crimean <u>prosecutor asks for four-year sentence</u> for hunger-striking activist.

Emir Usein Kuku announces hunger strike.

A Ukrainian activist Kostenko jailed in Russia has been put in solitary confinement weeks before his scheduled release.

At least 2,425 people have been evicted illegally from Crimea. In addition, 4,700 imprisoned Ukrainian citizens have been moved from Crimea to the territory of the Russian Federation.

<u>Sailors of YaMK-0041 vessel released</u>, but their passports were not returned. They can not leave the territory of Sevastopol.

In four months <u>231 foreigners visited occupied</u> <u>Crimea</u>.

<u>Lychakiv Cemetery, Lviv</u>: an open-air museum of history, culture, art and remembrance.


<u>Descendants of extinct Eurasian wild horses</u> bred in Ukrainian National Park.
