Most Ukrainians want peace in Donbas, but not at any cost

Apr 24. One Ukrainian <u>soldier killed in ATO zone</u> in last day.

April 19. <u>ICJ orders Russia to refrain from attacks</u> <u>on Mejlis and restrictions</u> on educational rights of ethnic Ukrainians. <u>What Ukraine won and lost</u>.

<u>Hague court to decide on further steps</u> in "Ukraine vs. Russia" case on May 12.

<u>Ukraine's army ranks 8th in Europe, is the only</u> <u>army capable of containing Russian aggression</u> effectively. - Poroshenko in London.
